Getting there

By train:

■ **Nearest train station:** Newcastle Central station is a 7-minute walk. Here is a video of the walk from the station to the venue:

By bus:

■ The QuayCity Loop bus runs frequently and stops at Forth Banks / Stephenson Quarter which is a 2-minute walk to Crowne Plaza Newcastle.

By air:

- Newcastle International Airport offer convenient access to the city
- A taxi from the airport to Crowne Plaza Newcastle will take approximately 15 - 20 minutes or can use the Metro or take a taxi from the terminal.

By taxi:

- Taxis are available outside Newcastle Central and Metro Stations, on Neville Street
- Cost of taxi is approximately £5-£9 per trip. Methods of payment available are: cash, card or contactless

By car:

From the south

■ Approach Newcastle via A1(M) northbound and continue along the A1(M) and then take the A184 to Gateshead Newcastle. Follow signs for City Centre, cross Tyne Bridge and then follow signs to Stephenson Quarter

From the north

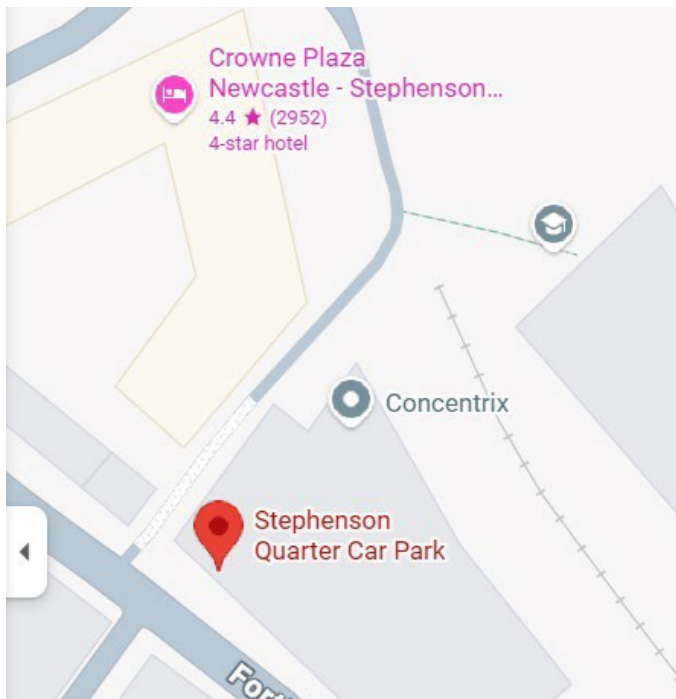
■ Take A1 southbound towards Newcastle and then exit onto A167 towards City Centre. Follow signs for Central Station and then turn onto Forth Street / Stephenson Quarter.

From the Wirral

- Join the M53 northbound and then continue onto the M56 eastbound. Then merge onto M6 northbound.
- Exit onto the M62 eastbound towards Leeds
- Continue onto the A1 northbound towards Newcastle and then exit at A184 towards Gateshead / Newcastle. Follow signs for City Centre, cross the Tyne Bridge and then follow signs for Stephenson Quarter.

Car park:

- The Stephenson Quarter multi-storey car park is located right next to the hotel with **direct access to the hotel from level 10**.
- The car park is pay by phone and operates on a fully **cashless** basis.
- Guests may make payment at the hotel reception. The overnight parking charge is **£10**

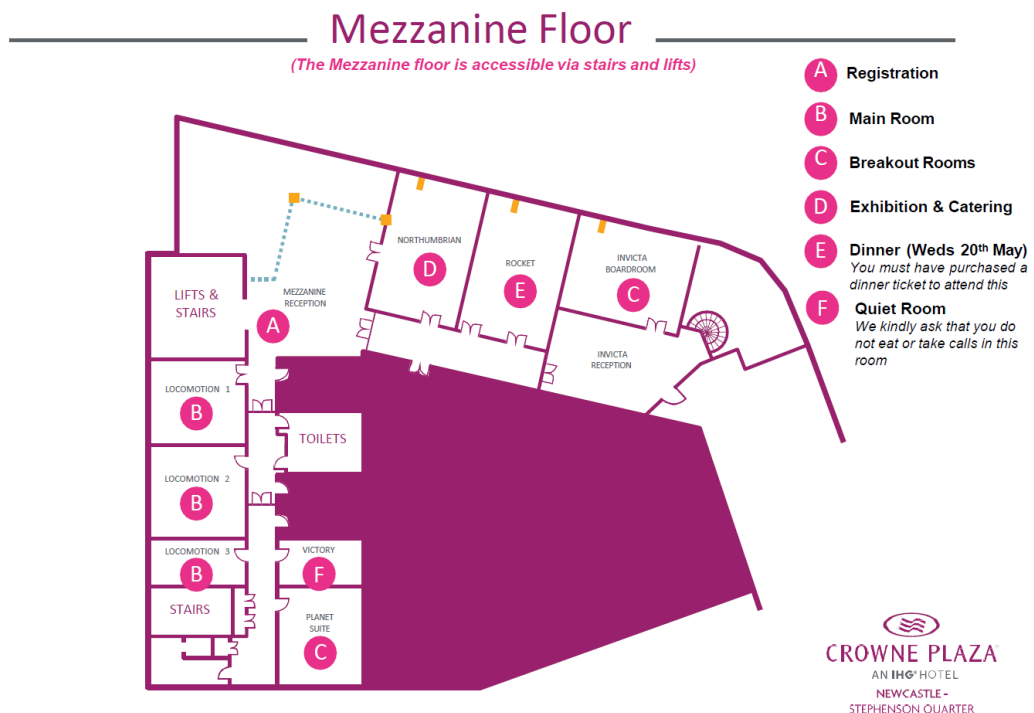
- Delegate hotel check-in
