


Birkbeck, University of London

PROBLEMS WE NOTED

GDPR is focussed on PROCESSING PURPOSES no DATA STORES

But staff don't get that

We have multiple disconnected processing activities

- To an extent within the set of activities supported by centrally provided IT
- Certainly when you include 'self-sourced' IT solutions



NO COMPLETE VIEW OF PROCESSING

This is a problem

- Most HEIs are a single data controller
- Transparency how can you clearly explain to a data subject what processing is being done?
- Individual Rights how can you act on requests under individual rights?
- Accountability & Governance requirements: documentation essentially you "need to know what you're processing, how, where and why"

- 99% of them historically using Eventbrite*





Anatomy of MPC for example individual





MORE ON MY PRIVACY CONTROL

- Auditing processing purposes (for an individual customer)
- Especially important for consent "why did I get sent this email?...."
- Withdrawal of consent



Studiosity

We are processing your personal data for the purpose of providing you with access to 'Studiosity'. Studiosity is a third party, online study support service.

Studiosity's 24/7 service allows you to submit assignment drafts for feedback on structure, language, grammar and punctuation. It also provides for you to access a live online tutor for help with maths and science questions. You are allowed up to 10 assignment submissions or live online tutor sessions (or a combination of both) per year.

You have consented to the processing of your personal data for this purpose (including the international transfer of your personal data to Studiosity - an independent third party service provider - based in Australia) as described in this Privacy Notice.


You have the right to withdraw consent at any time, which you can do by clicking Opt-out. Hease note however that once you have accessed Studiosity for the first time, your data will have been shared with Studiosity acting as an autonomous data controller, who will process your data in accordance with their terms and conditions which you will have agreed with them. We will act on your withdrawal of consent by ceasing to pass your data to Studiosity, ceasing to maintain records of your use (if any of the service), and informing Studiosity of your withdrawal of consent.

Where the lawful basis for processing is consent, we have to be able to provide a mechanism to withdraw consent



EVEN MORE ON MY PRIVACY CONTROL


- A mechanism for maintaining 'interests'
- A sub-set of Processing Purposes say we will process data to maintain contact about areas of interest
- For customers who have this processing purpose, we allow the maintenance of interests



The interests we allow control over vary by customer (e.g. students can select a wider list than prospects)





DUST IS STILL SETTLING

This is an iterative process

- There is lots of processing under the radar... but it is getting better
- DPIA process poorly understood... but again improving
- Having structure really helps, because then you are developing and extending something solid
- Not sure all of the sector are at the same part of the journey (some privacy notices still don't call out lawful basis of processing for example)

Clearly other issues too...

- Security is critical sector wide this is a current issue
- Resilience also important!








MY PRIVACY CONTROL (1)



Example: 'Brand new' person

- Visits My Privacy Control
- Enters their email address
- Gets emailed a link
- Follows link -> sees that there is no processing






MY PRIVACY CONTROL (2)


- Keep in touch resulting from
 - Opt-in to 'Keep in touch' via MPC
 - Book on Open Evening, Request Prospectus, Enquiry Form
 - Compete Interest Registration form
 - All require consent to Keep In Touch
 - MPC provides facility to remove consent

Example: Open Evening Booking








MY PRIVACY CONTROL (4)

Example: Applicant or student

- Sees 'Admissions and Study'
- Has a different set of 'interests' to pick from (based on rules)
