Rapport

- Process of responsiveness (not necessarily 'liking')
- Works at an unconscious level
- Capability to see each other's point of view
- Being on each other's wavelength



Rapport - Concepts

• Physiology

- Posture, gestures, facial expression, breathing

• Matching

- Replicating exactly some aspect of a person's physiology

• Mirroring

- Replicating the mirror image of an aspect of someone's physiology
